Meeting was called to order by Vice-Chairperson Krebs with the following board members responding to roll call: Pedersen, Smith, Jacob, and Krebs. Henery absent. Vice-Chairperson Krebs stated the open meeting laws are posted on the east wall of the Commissioner's Meeting Room with more copies available at the County Clerk's Office.




Zoning Permit Report for September was presented and put on file.

- **Hazard Mitigation**: Ms. Wingate reviewed the beginning of the Hazard Mitigation has started. Antelope County was well represented during the initial meeting; however, the schools did not provide representation. She will work on involving them for the next phase. Bobbi Risor and Ms. Wingate will continue to complete and update information.
- Foxhill Administrative Plat: Jerry and Char Carpenter are proposing to separate the building site from the farm ground. NPPD has easements along the north side, which should not affect the plat. Nays none. Motion passed. Highway Superintendent, Brian McDonald presented a map and list of current project list. This list is essentially the same as presented last month. Some of the construction amounts have been updated. The public hearing is a requirement for federal fund support. Vice-Chairperson Krebs asked for input from the Commissioners. No response. At 9:18 AM asked for comments from the public, asked twice. No public response. Discussion of Project numbers 407, 409, and 418 is part of the bid quote for concrete project at \$1.78 million. Various short discussion on projects. 9:23 AM

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Speed Sign: 513th Avenue starting at 6th Street extending north of Orchard, 0.5 miles. The study was completed by Highway Superintendent with he recommendation of adding a 35 MPH sign starting at 6th Street and extending north 1200'. The signage would have to be placed at 6th Street for north bound traffic and at 1200' north for south bond traffic. A 55 MPH sign will need to be placed at 1200' north of 6th Street for northbound vehicles. Discussion of the speed limit going from 55 MPH down to 25 MPH is not MUDTC recommended. Adding the 35 MPH would be an ideal buffer. Motion by Commissioner Pedersen, seconded by Commissioner Jacob, to approve setting and placing a sign for the speed limit at 35 MPH. Speed limit west of Neligh, by Bomgaars. Commissioner Pedersen mentioned, the speed limit seems to increase before the end of city limits and seems to create some traffic hazards. Commissioners all agreed. Brian will look at it and write a letter.

Logan Township 25/25-23-7: Landowner, Dave Beckman inquired about the vacation of a road between Section 24 and 25 in Logan Township. On February 8, 1983, the Antelope County Board of Supervisors, after being petitioned and studied vacated an approximate one (1) mile stretch between Sections 24 and 25. However, at that time they retained the Right of Way to the 'road'. Discussion of various options and opportunities. Highway Superintendent believed the BOC could resolution the relinquishment of the Right of Way, however that it would be in the best interest of the County to check with the County Attorney, and Antelope County Insurance. The Clerk will check with both, and if ok, will prepare a resolution stating the same. No action today.

Road Superintendent Report:

- Underground Permit: Motion by Commissioner Smith, seconded by Commissioner Jacob to approve the application for an underground permit in the SE¹/₄ Section 11, Township 23, Range 7, West of the 6th P.M. Antelope County, Nebraska. Purpose is fiber optic cable to carry data. Mr. Boggs voiced no issues. Voting aye: Smith, Jacob, Pedersen and Krebs. Henery absent. Nays none. Motion carried.
- **Dust Control:** Mr. Boggs stated he went to Husker Harvest Days and spoke with a company called Dust Lock regarding a soybean based application for dust control on gravel/dirt road. He reports mots of the information was for slow traveling roads and he was not sure if it would benefit on roads with heavy and higher speed traffic. Mr. Boggs estimates the cost at about \$13,000.00 \$14,000.00 a mile. Long discussion about heavy or a thick coat verses a thin coat possible multiple times over a season. Mr. Boggs will complete more research. No further action.

No other issues to discuss.
