The Antelope County Board of Commissioner's convened as a County Board of Equalization on Tuesday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2018 at 9:37 AM in the County Commissioner's Room, Antelope County Courthouse Annex, Neligh, Nebraska. Meeting called to order by Chairman Kerkman with the following board members responding to roll call: Schindler, Jacob Henery, Schwager and Kerkman. Chairman Kerkman stated that the open meeting laws are posted on the east wall of the Commissioner's room with more copies available at the County Clerk's office.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the four county newspapers, legal newspapers printed and in general circulation in Antelope County, Nebraska as shown by proof of publication filed in the County Clerk's office.
