The Antelope County Board of Supervisor's convened in regular session on Tuesday, September 2, 2014 at 9:00 AM in the County Supervisor's room, Antelope County Courthouse annex, Neligh, Nebraska. Meeting called to order by Chairman Schwager with the following board members responding to roll call: Brandt, Kerkman, Baker, Williby, Henery and Schwager. Bolling absent. Chairman Schwager stated that the open meeting laws are posted on the east wall of the Supervisor's room with more copies available at the County Clerk's office.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in the four county newspapers, legal newspapers printed and in general circulation in Antelope County, Nebraska as shown by proof of publication filed in the County Clerk's office. Agenda for said meeting was sent to all members of the County Board of Supervisor's.

Planning Commission board member Mark Smith met with the county board and asked if the county board could request that the county attorney attend all Planning Commission meetings and if he is not available if the board could appoint someone as legal counsel for them. Mr. Smith stated that there are issues that come up at the hearings that the Planning Commission board members do not have the answers for and legal counsel would be very helpful. The board said they would speak with the county attorney and ask him to attend the planning commission meetings and if he is unable they will find an attorney who could be at the meetings.

Motion by Henery, seconded by Williby to accept the resignation of Antelope County Weed Control Authority board member David L. Willats effective 9-1-2014. Those voting aye: Brandt, Kerkman, Baker, Williby, Henery and Schwager. Nays none. Bolling absent. Motion carried.

Supervisors Henery, Kerkman and Baker will conduct the 3rd quarter jail inspection.

Motion by Kerkman, seconded by Baker to approve the August 5, 2014, August 12, 2014 and the August 19, 2014 regular board minutes. Those voting aye: Kerkman, Baker, Williby, Henery, Brandt and Schwager. Nays none. Bolling absent. Motion carried.

Concentrated Animal Feeding Operation – NDEQID: 66026 – Program ID: LWC 26-007 – Notice of Application for Major Modification Received NE1/4, Section 8, Township 23 North, Range 8 West, Antelope County – prepared by Settje Agri-Services and Engineering, Inc.; thank you from the Elgin Community Club for the \$1500.00 grant received from the County Improvement Fund; and a letter from Mike Foley, Auditor of Public Accounts stating that their office will begin the county audit on September 8, 2014.

Supervisor Henery stated that No Parking signs need to be placed along the roads where the Willie Nelson concert will be taking place. The signs will be placed along the first mile of 857th Road west of Highway 14 and along 523rd Avenue the first ½ mile south between 857th and 856th Road. Motion by Henery, seconded by Williby to place no parking signs along the first mile of 857th Road west of Highway 14 and along 523rd Avenue the first ½ mile south between 857th and 856th Road during the Willie Nelson concert. Those voting aye: Baker, Williby, Henery, Brandt, Kerkman and Schwager. Nays none. Bolling absent. Motion carried.

Antelope County Sheriff Robert E. Moore met with the board to discuss purchasing a 4/Wheeler for the custodian and the sheriff's office to use. A proposal from Big Red Motorsports for a 2014 Arctic Cat 550 Limited with front and rear bumpers, winch and 50" snow plow in the amount of \$9,777.00 was presented. The

proposal was reviewed and the board asked Sheriff Moore to get two more proposals and present them at the September 9, 2014 meeting.

Mr. Art Tanderup along with Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd Meis owners of the White Spot Bar met with the county board to request a Special Designated Liquor License to serve alcoholic beverages at the Harvest of Hope event to be held at Mr. Tanderup's place on September 27, 2014. Antelope County Sheriff Robert E. Moore was also present for the meeting. Sheriff Moore stated that the County Sheriff's office supports the idea of having a beer garden at this event since it will help to control the alcohol being brought into this event. He also asked the county board that if they did approve the special designated liquor license that they make a provision in the motion that the event organizers have to have a security company hired and in place before the event takes place. Supervisor Henery stated that he would like to see not only a fence around the beer garden but also a perimeter fence be placed around the beer garden with a space between the beer garden fence and the perimeter fence of about 6-10' where only the security staff would be allowed to occupy. Henery felt that this would deter anyone from passing the beverages over the fence and out into the crowd where the beverages are not allowed. Mr. Tanderup stated that he felt that this was a good idea and he would make sure that this was done. He also stated that only individuals of legal age to drink would be allowed in the beer garden, that ID's would be check and bracelets given out to those individuals. Motion by Henery, seconded by Kerkman to approve the special designated liquor license request received from Coleen Meis and Lloyd Meis owners of the White Spot Bar for catering alcoholic beverages at the Harvest of Hope event to be held on September 27th, 2014 from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM, that a controlled area be placed around the beer garden, that bracelets be issued to designate individuals old enough to drink, and that the event organizers hire a security company and have them in place prior to the event; said location will be a 7 ½ acre tract located on the SW corner of the SW1/4 of Section 5, Township 26 North, Range 6 West of the 6th P.M., Antelope County, Nebraska. Those voting aye: Williby, Henery, Brandt, Kerkman, Baker and Schwager. Nays none. Bolling absent. Motion carried.

Antelope County Highway Superintendent Brain McDonald met with the board to discuss the No Parking signs along the designated route for the Willie Nelson concert. Mr. McDonald said that he had completed a sign study for the No Parking signs and has drawn up a resolution which needs to be adopted listing the roads where the No Parking signs would be placed and listing the dates the signs would be posted through. Motion by Henery, seconded by Williby to resend his motion made earlier regarding the No Parking signs. Those voting aye: Henery, Brandt, Kerkman, Baker, Williby and Schwager. Nays none. Bolling absent. Motion carried. Motion by Henery, seconded by Williby to adopt the resolution stating that temporary no parking signs be placed along 857th Road starting at Highway 14 and extending west 1.5 miles; 855th Road starting at Highway 14 and extending 1 mile west to 523rd Avenue; and 523rd Avenue between 855th Road and 857th Road; said signs to be posted from September 26, 2014 through September 29, 2014. Those voting aye: Henery, Brandt, Kerkman, Baker, Williby and Schwager. Nays none. Bolling absent. Motion carried.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-09-0001
ANTELOPE COUNTY, NEBRASKA

WHEREAS, a musical event is planned for the weekend of September 27, 2014 located near the intersection of 857th Road and 523 Avenue that will result in increased traffic to the area for that weekend.

WHEREAS, the County Sheriff has recommended that traffic will be directed in and out of the event using 2 routes from Highway 14. The first include 857th Road from Highway 14 west to the 523rd intersection. The second route starting at 855th Road intersection with Highway 14, extends west to 523 Avenue, then north 2 miles to 857th Road.

WHEREAS, the Highway Superintendent has reviewed the parking conditions along the proposed roads and has recommended that temporary no parking zones be established along both routes recommended by the Sheriff as well as the addition of 857th for the first ½ mile west of 523 Avenue.

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to prevent road side parking starting September 26, 2014 and extending through September 29, 2014 along 857th Road starting at Highway 14 and extending west 1.5 miles; 855th Road Starting at Highway 14 and extending 1 mile west to 523 Avenue; and 523 Avenue between 855th Road and 857th Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of Antelope County, Nebraska, that the temporary no parking zones be established for the roads designated above and that signs be erected for enforcement during the period of time specified.
