NACO Annual Update: Beth Ferrell, legal counsel representative from NACO met with the Commissioners regarding updates from the legislative session and numerous other ideas, actions and updates. various subjects including license plate number t changed in 2029, ATV-UTV can be used for snow removal from sunrise to sunset, abandonment of vacated roads no longer needs study (still needs hearing, etc.) open-meetings law changed, after 2028 the County does not have to provide office space for DHHS, tax sale process changes, budget property cap, mental health pilot project with correctional facilities, inheritance tax - carryover until next session. She reminded the Commissioners NACO is available if needed. No further action.

## **Road Superintendent Report:**

**Permits:** Motion by Commissioner Krebs, seconded by Commissioner Jacob to approve permits as presented. Voting aye: Krebs, Dittrich, Williby, Jacob and Henery. Nays none. Motion carried.

- Underground Permits: North Central Public Power District submitted a right of way permit to provide secondary wires to service residential house – alleviating tree issues with old service. Line will begin approximately 1300' south of 867th Road and cross 534th Avenue in the NE1/4 of Section 24, Township 28, Range 5 and ending in the NW1/4 Section 19, Township 28, Range 4. The owner is Tyson Bolling. Mr. Kluthe voices no opposition.
- Underground Permits: Plumbing and Electrical Service of out Hartington Nebraska submitted an Right of Way permit to go under 869th Road north of 527th Avenue, located in Section 12, Township 28, Range 8 west of the 6th PM, Antelope County, Nebraska. Reg Green is the owner, Jim Kulish is the tenant. Mr. Kluthe has worked with contractors and all is in order, he reports no issues.
- Oversize Permit: (189-190-191) Landwehr Construction out of St. Cloud Minnesota submitted three (3) oversize load permits to access Tower 87. Routes 1) is Highway 70 west to 520th Avenue south to Tower 87; 2) 100th Street west to highway 14 south to 110th Street west to 520th Avenue north to Tower 87; 3) Highway 70 west to 520th Avenue south to Tower 87. Mr. Kluthe approved of the routes as long as there was no rain. The move has been executed. No issues were reported.
- Oversize Permit: (192-193) In and out. Crane Service Inc. submitted a permit to access Tower 80. Mr. Kluthe suggested Highway 70 to 520<sup>th</sup> Avenue south to Tower 80. No issues reported. Move has been executed.
- Underground Permit: Two Rivers Irrigation submitted an underground permit to go under 857th Road in the SE1/4 Section 2, Township 26, Range 7 West of the 6<sup>th</sup> P.M., Antelope County, Nebraska. To provide electricity to irrigation services. Bill Ahlstedt is the owner. Mr. Kluthe states no issues.
- Clearwater Tractor: high temperature-transmission light is back in shop not sure what is going on.
- Patching: 513th North of Orchard-patching is complete. Crack sealing is happening now.
- Trench widening: Employees are working on trench widening south of Highway 20 to the school,
- Employees: Bob Hart resigned. Travis Schaefer new hire. Ray Schlecht retired on May 31st.
- Auction Time: most items have been paid for and picked up. Dodge Durango has not been paid for or picked up.
